## 6 CLASSIC CALI LAGUNA BEACH

**WHY GO** The epitome of California cool, this onetime artists' community is known for its long sunny days and miles of pristine sandy beaches. No wonder it's part of the "California Riviera."

**It's a wrap: shades, Oliver Peoples, \$360; 866-865-7599**

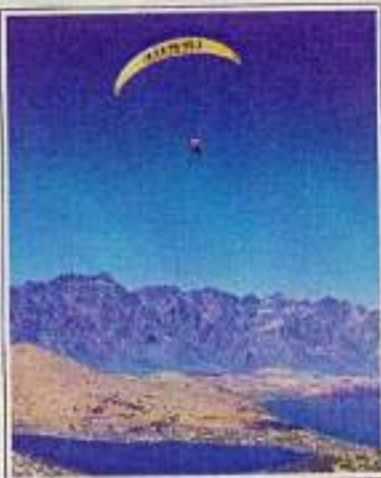


**STAY** All 262 rooms at Montage Resort & Spa (below, from \$560; 888-715-6700) have ocean views, original artwork and 400-thread-count sheets. Enjoy the infinity pool or take a dip in the Pacific. Sightings: Heather Locklear and Pierce Brosnan.



**SEE/DO** Loll all day on Aliso Beach, then indulge in the citrus body polish at the spa; dine outdoors on swordfish brochettes and seared tuna at Hush, the new boîte in town. **PACK** Beach fare: *Music from The OC: Mix 1* and Marcelle Clements's novel *Midsummer*

## 7 ADRENALINE RUSH NEW ZEALAND



**WHY GO** Calling all heli-skiers: Queenstown is the daredevil's current destination of choice, as much for its jaw-dropping scenery as for the endless thrill options.

**STAY** Please your inner hedonist at Eichardt's Private Hotel (below, from \$789; 800-525-4800). The five luxury suites boast fur throws, heated bathroom floors and ample reserves of port (it's winter here, remember?).

**SEE/DO** Skydive in the Queenstown Basin; bungee-jump the 440-foot Nevis drop; test snowboarding skills on Coronet Peak (Elijah Wood and Orlando Bloom reportedly have); refuel on prime New Zealand beef at Wai, a waterfront stalwart.

**PACK** A berry-colored fleece micro-hoodie from Burton (\$65; 800-881-3138)



## 8 SHAPE UP TULUM

**WHY GO** You have a week off and want a beachside retreat that will focus your mind and body: a Mexican destination to cultivate peace (and a six-pack—no margaritas).

**STAY** Sign up for Amansala Eco Chic Resort's Bikini Boot Camp (\$1,575; [amansala.com](http://amansala.com)), where Linda Evangelista went for a week of jungle walks, Pilates sessions and morning yoga. Hydrate with gallons of *agua de limón* and dine guilt-free on grilled fish and jicama salad. Sleep soundly in your breezy thatched-roof palapa (Susan Sarandon did).
